How do antidepressants work?

Full study title: *Investigating the effects of antidepressants on belief-updating, social functioning, and mood in people with depression*



We are researching how antidepressants affect thinking processes, social interactions, and mood.

You could be eligible to take part if you have depression symptoms and:

- **plan to start taking antidepressants (or started in the last 2 weeks)**

OR

- **do not plan to take antidepressants for your depression symptoms**

You would receive £10 per hour for your time.

What's involved?

- 4 online meetings with a researcher over a period of 8 weeks. You would complete some computerised tasks and questionnaires about your mental health. Each meeting would last 30 minutes - 2 hours (it would take 5 hours and 30 minutes overall to attend every meeting).
- Filling in 6 short surveys on your phone throughout the day about your mood, mental and physical health, and social interactions for 4 weeks (taking about 10 minutes per day).
